CLINICAL SERVICES

NETWORK OF SUPPORT

COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH ASSESSMENT

A Registered Nurse will meet with you to complete a comprehensive health assessment and care plan. Our nurse provides support and teaching regarding pain and symptom management as well as health care system navigation and advocacy.

DAY HOSPICE PROGRAM

Led by a Registered Nurse, and a team of trained volunteers, Day Hospice offers support to clients and respite for caregivers. Clients enjoy a nutritious home cooked meal and a variety of weekly activities in our home-like setting.

Thursdays 10:00am - 3:00pm Transportation may be provided.

IN-HOME VISITING

Trained volunteers are matched with clients/families. They provide emotional support and companionship to clients while providing respite to the family.

MEDICAL EQUIPMENT LENDING

BDH provides a wide range of assistive equipment to support clients at home. Equipment is loaned for a 3-month period. A full listing of equipment is available on our website.

COUNSELLING SERVICES

Individual, family and group therapy provided by an Integrative Counselling Therapist. Available to those diagnosed with a life-limiting illness, or anyone in the community who is bereaved.

SUPPORT AND SHARE GROUPS

Bereavement Support Group: Gather with others to share experiences, process loss and find healing.

Program runs 5:30-7pm on the 2nd Wednesday of each month.

Caregiver Coffee: An opportunity for caregivers to connect and discuss the privileges, successes, strains, and challenges they are facing.

Program runs 1-2:30pm on the last Tuesday of each month.

HEALTH & WELLNESS ACTIVITIES

BDH Health and Wellness Programs include: Therapeutic Art, Meditation, Walking Groups, Guided Journaling, Dance/Movement therapy, and Spiritual Care.

HEALING GARDEN AND LABYRINTH

Surround yourself with the peace and tranquility of nature as you relax and reflect in the Beth Donovan Hospice Healing Garden and Labyrinth.

EXPANDED LEARNING

Educational Presentations, Book Club meetings, Death Cafes are run throughout the year.
